Students applying for the enhanced diploma for World Languages must meet the following requirements:

- **Select one of the following three options to complete:**

Option 1:
Complete 3 years of language classes (or 3 credits if taking 2 languages in same year) throughout their 10-12th grade years and earn 100 Activity/Award points.

Option 2:
Take level 4 and/or AP with a minimum of 2 years in 10-12th grade year and earn 150 Activity/Award points.

Option 3:
Complete 2 years of ASL and earn 150 Activity/Award points

- **Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and a 3.5 cumulative GPA in Language classes**
- **Attach a transcript with World Languages highlighted to verify grades and GPA**
- **Earn Activity/Award points**
Accumulate points needed (100 for Option 1 or 150 for Options 2 or 3) by participating in the activities listed below **during your 10-12th grade years.** Record points on back.

<i>10 Points</i>	<i>Student of the Month- Must have teacher signature to verify</i>
<i>5-10 Points each</i>	<i>Other World Language Honors/Awards. Point value determined at teacher's discretion</i>
<i>5 Points each day</i>	<i>MAP Peer tutoring (at teacher's request)- Must have requesting teacher signature</i>
<i>20-50 Points</i>	<i>Special Project—Point value determined at teacher's discretion</i>
<i>50 Points</i>	<i>World Language AP Exam</i>
<i>10-50 Points</i>	<i>Sterling Scholar (Applicant 10 pts, Runner-up 30 pts, Winner 50 pts)</i>
