- **Have a cumulative GPA of 3.8 or higher**
- **9th Grade: A minimum of four academic core classes** (Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies and World Language).
- **10th – 12th Grade: Four honors, AP or concurrent academic core classes taken each year which come from the Advanced Course list below.**
- **9th – 12th Grade: A grade of “B” or higher reflected on your transcript in each of the qualifying core classes** (any grade of B- will disqualify the applicant).
