Financial institutions and banks are also at the end of the list. It is a good idea to ask your employer, and your parents' employers, if they offer any college scholarships. There are many academic, departmental and other scholarships available through the colleges and universities which are generally not included here. Please research those scholarships through those institutions directly. And remember to keep applying for scholarships while you are attending college as well!
