Use the following list to identify the qualifying activities and their point value:

Points	Eligible Mustang Activities
5	Membership and participation in a Herriman H.S. club, such as HOSA, MESA, Hearts of Gold, etc...
5	Serve as an officer in a Herriman H.S. organization or club other than Student Government or PLT
10	Participation in a Herriman H.S. athletic sport or club sport
10	Earn a Letter Award in academics, athletics or art
20	Serve as an officer in the Herriman H.S. Student Government
10	Participate on a non-sport competitive Herriman H.S. team such as Debate, Skills U.S.A., FBLA, FFA, etc...
20	Sterling Scholar
15	Member of a Herriman High performing group such as Drama, Choir, Dance, Band, Cheer, Drill etc...
15	Member of a Youth Leadership Organization such as, PLT, DECA, FBLA, Hope Squad, etc...
20	Serve as an officer in PLT or Hope Squad
20	Serve as a mentor to another student- verified by your assigned HHS counselor
