- A. The USBE's Seal of Biliteracy will be awarded to students who earn a Utah high school diploma and are proficient in English and at least one world language other than English, at the <a href="intermediate-mid">intermediate-mid</a> level or higher, as demonstrated through an assessment from a list to be approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- B. For purposes of this form, "world language" means a language other than English, and includes American Sign Language, Latin, and American Native Languages.
